Moderation is a valuable process that helps teachers by giving honest feedback that ensures all children in the school are assessed in a fair and equitable manner.

Students are currently preparing for Student Led Conferences that will take place next Wednesday from 5:30 – 6:30pm. During these conferences your child / children will share with you the learning areas where they feel they are performing well and discuss areas where they are aiming for improvement.

For parents who have not previously been involved in this process the focus is on children leading the conference – teachers will be in attendance to support children in their organisation; however, the aim of the evening is for children to think about their learning and effectively communicate their opinions, ideas and improvement targets with their parents.

Siblings will be supervised by Mr. Neville in the Music Room.

#### National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN)

LIPS students in years 3, 5 and 7 have completed the NAPLAN tests last week and the test papers have been returned to Australia for marking. School and student results will be disseminated to families next term after results have been returned to the school.
